*Please make a note of these dates if your child is participating in a club.*

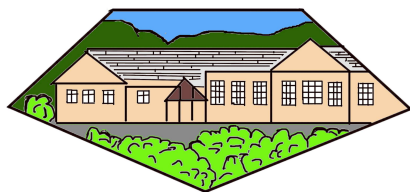
Some clubs are weather dependent and a text will be sent if weather conditions prevent the club from happening.

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## LAMDA: Speech and Drama Classes

Diggle School is pleased to offer LAMDA Speech and Drama lessons from Year 1. From January Adele Taylor (LLAMDA) will come into school to teach a drama class after school on a Tuesday, 3.15-4.15pm

The syllabus consists of a series of graded examinations and allows the children to work on pieces of drama, poetry & prose.

LAMDA examinations are designed to equip learners, whatever their age or aspirations, with a range of skills which will serve them throughout life. They can:

- Unlock imagination and creative thinking
- Build self-confidence and self-esteem
- Develop communication skills
- Refine technical skills and artistry
- Promote team-work.

The aim is to develop a love, appreciation and understanding of language and literature through learning and speaking aloud, and to offer a progressive education and training in communication through speech.

The sessions are £4 per week, places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis booked via Parent Pay. For those who want to take the exams - they will take place in the summer term - exam fees are additional and vary according to grade. Please note - taking the exam is not compulsory.
