Dear Parents

We have an exciting programme of Christmas celebrations during December involving all our children for which tickets will go on sale on Monday 19th November. For most events, initial limitations are in place on number of tickets available per family to ensure **everyone** has the same chance to obtain tickets. The ticket restrictions are different depending on how many children are involved and the venue. Full details are below. For the nativity tickets, and the Brass, Orchestra and Woodwind Concert only, any unsold tickets will be made available without restriction on a first come first served basis on afternoon of Friday 7th December.

Class R Nativity

Class R will be presenting their first nativity production on **Tuesday 18th December** at 9.30am. This will take place in the school hall, and FODS will be providing refreshments from 8.45am.

Tickets will be £2 each and will initially be limited to 3 per family.

Class 1 & 2 Nativity

Classes 1 & 2 will perform their joint nativity twice on **Tuesday 18th December** at 2.15pm and again on **Wednesday 19th December** at 9.30am. These will take place in the school hall and refreshments will be available from 1.30pm on the 18th and 8.45am on the 19th, again kindly provided by FODS.

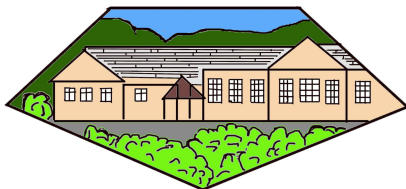
Tickets are £2 each and will be **limited to 4 per family**. On Parent Pay, both productions will be listed and each limited to 4 tickets as you may wish to purchase 4 tickets for one performance and none for the other, or 3 for one and 1 for another etc, however this means that a total of 8 tickets will be available to you. **Please respect the restriction** – any tickets purchased beyond the initial 4 will be refunded. **Please note**, while we are restricting the tickets for each family to enable everyone a chance to purchase tickets, **there is also a limit on capacity for both performances** so if you can only make one performance, please ensure you get your tickets early.

Classes 3, 4, 5 & 6 Christingle Concert

The KS2 Christingle Concert will take place on Wednesday 19th December, 2pm at Kiln Green Church Hall. All KS2 children will be taking part, and the children who have singing lessons will also perform.

Given the number of children involved and the capacity of the hall, we are only able to offer 1 ticket per family. Where there are multiple siblings in KS2, the ticket will be available on the eldest child's profile. Please also note that no extra unsold tickets will be going on sale at a later date for this concert.
