Dear Parents and Carers

Children will begin taking part in PE lessons as of next week and it is important that all children have the correct PE kit in school, so that they are able to participate in these lessons properly. As the weather can be unpredictable at this time of year it is important that children have clothing for both indoor and outdoor use; as PE lessons do not always just take place inside. Please make sure your child has the following:

- White t-shirt
- Navy blue/black shorts
- Navy blue/ black tracksuit bottoms
- Navy blue/black jacket
- A pair of trainers.
- Pumps (optional) for indoor use only.

If children are taking part in orienteering as part of their PE lessons, they usually do this by changing into their outdoor shoes (wellies or walking boots) but do not change into full PE kit.

Children are timetabled to 2 PE lessons a week and so it is essential that their kit is in school during a half term. Staff will send PE kits home at the end of each half term to be washed.

If your child participates in an after school club they can also do this in their PE kit or bring a separate kit for that day, however, children will not get changed again at the end of the club so PE kit will need returning to school the following day.
